Hindi Diwas (हिन्दी दिवस) is celebrated in India to commemorate the date 14 September 1949 on which a compromise was reached—during the drafting of the Constitution of India—on the languages that were to have official status in the Republic of India. On this day, the Constituent Assembly of India decided by one vote that Hindi would be the official language of India.

The day is also important as over 180 million people around the world speak Hindi as their first language while 300 million people have Hindi as their second.
